Erratum

The following errors in the *RCMP Command Post, Operational Communications Centre, and Command Decisions* Foundational Document have come to the attention of Commission Counsel:

1. Paragraphs 48, 52, 55, 57, 59, 118, 136, 147, 165, 192, 229, 292, 293, 308, 311 – Donna Lee Williston

In paragraphs 48, 52, 55, 57, 59, 118, 136, 147, 165, 192, 229, 292, 293, 308, and 311, as well as the Key Command and Communication Members sections for hours one through six, Donna Lee Williston's name is erroneously spelled Donnalee Williston.

2. Paragraph 152 - Corrie Ellison

In paragraph 152, a "[sic]" should be inserted after the misspelling of Corrie Ellison's name as "Cory Ellison".

3. Paragraph 314 – Critical Incident

In the note under paragraph 314, "critical incident response" is erroneously spelled "critical incient response".

4. Paragraph 354 - District Policing Officer

A note below paragraph 354 states, "Efforts are ongoing to ascertain the identity of the district policing officer." As noted elsewhere in the Foundational Document, the District Policing Officer at the time was Supt. Archie Thompson.

5. Paragraph 380 - Scott Healey

In paragraph 380, Scott Healey's name is erroneously spelled Scott Healy.

6. Paragraph 428 – S/Sgt. Bruce Briers

Paragraph 428 states, "While speaking with Laura Brine, RM Rehill received a call from Sgt. Sutherland...". In fact, it was Risk Manager S/Sgt. Bruce Briers who was speaking with Laura Brine at this time and received a call from Sgt. Sutherland, not Risk Manager S/Sgt. Brian Rehill.

7. Paragraph 624 – Insp. Darrin Smith

In paragraph 624, Insp. Darrin Smith's name is erroneously spelled Insp. Darren Smith.
