1. Supplementary Statement of Cpl. R. Peterson: COMM0046232

On January 25, 2022, Cpl. Rodney Peterson provided the Mass Casualty Commission with a supplementary statement to clarify answers given during his interview with the Commission. This statement (COMM0046232) and the enclosing email sent to the Commission (COMM0046231) will be tendered into evidence.

2. Mass Casualty Commission interview of Angela Porter: COMM0050871

On January 21, 2022, the Mass Casualty Commission interviewed Angela Porter who saw what she believed was an RCMP vehicle north of the Fisher residence travelling north on Highway 4 and then east on Plains Road. The transcript of this interview (COMM0050871) will be tendered into evidence.

Erratum

The following errors in the *Highway 4, Glenholme* Foundational Document have come to the attention of Commission Counsel:

1. Paragraph 21 – Incorrect First Name

Paragraph 21 states that Cpl. Peterson spoke on the phone with Csts. Trent Lafferty and Adam MacDonald. In fact, he spoke with Csts. Trent Lafferty and Rodney MacDonald.

2. Paragraph 51 – Radio Citation

The citation for paragraph 51 for Colchester radio incorrectly contained pinpoints: "4496–99, 4505–59, 4566–67". The citation should instead read: "Colchester radio: COMM0003806 at lines 4596-98."
