On June 6, 2022, Mass Casualty Commission investigators prepared a supplementary report on the GPS data of EHS ambulance M-086, which was operated by paramedics Emily MacLeod and Jesse Brine on the evening of April 18, 2020. Ms. MacLeod and Mr. Brine advised the Commission that while they were in Great Village en route to Portapique that evening they observed a vehicle that they now believe was operated by the perpetrator.
