Erratum

The following errors in the *Perpetrator's Violent Behaviour Towards Other*s Foundational Document has come to the attention of Commission Counsel:

- 1. Key Witnesses and Paragraph 157 Spelling of Lisa Delong's name
- Lisa Delong's name was misspelled as Lisa Delonge in both the Key Witnesses section and in paragraph 157.
- 2. Key Witnesses and Paragraph 168 Spelling of Miriam Cleough's name

Miriam Cleough's name was misspelled as Miriam Cleogh in both the Key Witnesses section and in paragraph 168.

3. Paragraph 212 - Conversation between Cst. MacMinn and Sgt. Poirier

Paragraph 212 contains the following sentence: "Cst. MacMinn advised Sgt. Poirier that he would follow up with Cst. Wiley and then contact Sgt. Poirier with the updated information." At page 4 of Cst. MacMinn's written answers to questions, provided June 13, 2022, Cst. MacMinn stated the following: "I don't recall telling Sgt. Poirier that I would call him back. I recall telling him that I would pass on his message to Cst. Wiley, which I did."
