The *Information Seeking from Families and Next of Kin Notifications* Foundational Document was exhibited on June 22, 2022 in the Mass Casualty Commission’s public proceedings.

Erratum

The following errors in the *Information Seeking from Families and Next of Kin Notifications* Foundational Document have come to the attention of Commission Counsel:

1. Paragraph 79 – First Phone Call to Jon Farrington

Paragraph 79 reads “Cst. Bent then called Jon Farrington at 11:46 a.m.” Jon and Ryan Farrington say confirmation of death did not occur at this time.

2. Paragraph 81 – John Zahl and Joanne Thomas

Paragraph 81 reads “John Zahl and Joanne Thomas were residents of Portapique. John Zahl and Joanne Thomas died between 10:27 p.m. and 10:40 p.m. on April 18, 2020.” Instead, it should read “Joanne Thomas and John Zahl died in their home on Portapique Beach Road sometime after 10:26 p.m. on April 18, 2020.” This reflects the time of the last outgoing text message from Joanne Thomas.

3. Paragraph 289 – Years of Service

Paragraph 289 lists Cst. Heidi Stevenson as a 14 year member of the RCMP when in fact she served 23 years with the RCMP.
